Dear Mr. THOMAS VARRO:

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has reviewed the referenced air pollution control permit application. On the basis of the information provided, the Department concludes that the application satisfies all applicable requirements of the New Jersey Air Pollution Control regulations codified at N.J.A.C. 7:27 et seq.. This Air Pollution Control Permit shall supersede any existing Air Pollution Control Permits issued for the specified source. This permit allows for inspection and evaluation of the equipment by the Department to assure conformance with all provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:27 et seq. and any other applicable federal requirements codified at 40 CFR 52, 60, 61 and 63.

The equipment that is authorized to be installed and operated under this approval is described in Section A, Source Operations. Equipment at the facility referenced by this Permit shall be operated in accordance with the Conditions of Approval set forth in the attached document titled "Facility Specific Requirements" in Section D.

The Department hereby issues this permit and certificate under the authority of chapter 106, P.L. 1967(N.J.S.A 26:2C-9.2). You may construct, reconstruct, install, or modify the above referenced equipment and/or control apparatus consistent with the approval.

In addition to the facility specific requirements listed in this permit, the facility must comply with all applicable rules and requirements as well as the information contained in the approved application. The facility must also comply with any applicable requirements of the NJAC 7:27-8.1 et.seq. and other state rules summarized in the General Provisions for Pre-Construction Permits. The facility should take note, however, that this website may not always contain the most up-to-date version of these provisions.

It remains the facility's responsibility to keep apprised of and comply with all applicable regulations and changes thereto. 
This Air Pollution Control Pre-Construction Permit and Certificate to Operate is being issued as a 5-year operating certificate.

We are also including diskette with an electronic file. This diskette includes the inventories and permit requirements listed in the enclosed hard copy of the Air Pollution Control Permit. Upon importing this information into your Personal Computer with RADIUS software, you will have up to date information in the RADIUS format. This electronic file should not be used to prepare a permit modification application if and when you would need to submit one to the Department. A permit modification application should always be prepared using a new and blank RADIUS file. We encourage you to use the most recent RADIUS version. The RADIUS software, instruction, and help are available at the Department's website at [www.state.nj.us/dep/aqpp](http://www.state.nj.us/dep/aqpp).

If, in your judgement as an applicant for an air pollution control permit, the Department is imposing any unreasonable Condition of Approval, you may contest the Department's decision and request a contested case hearing pursuant to the Administrative Code at N.J.A.C. 7:27-1.32(a). All requests for contested case hearings must be received in writing by the Department within twenty (20) calendar days of the date you receive this permit approval and must contain the information specified in Section F (Permit Action Appeal Form).
