

Fluorescent Bulb Recycling

Compact Fluorescent Light bulbs (CFLs) and **Fluorescent tubes/lamps** contain mercury and **should not** be disposed in regular trash.



Use one of the following recycling options:

Home Depot or Lowes (unbroken CFLs only)

SCMUA Residents' Convenience Center

- ✓ Unbroken straight tubes/ and u-tubes only
- ✓ Limit of 10 tubes per resident*
