EFFECTIVE DATE: December 1, 2020  
SUBJECT: SCMUA Guidelines for Recyclable Materials for  
Large Quantity Generators (LQG)  
(Commercial, Private and Local Government Recycling Haulers)

Attention all Commercial, Private and Local Government Haulers that deliver *Class A Recyclable Material* to the SCMUA Solid Waste/Recycling Facility.

**I. Rate Schedule Notice - Effective December 1, 2020:**

- The rate for ID 702C Clean Commingled Containers is **\$20.00 per ton\***
  - The rate for ID 703 Fiber (Newspaper, Cardboard, Office Paper, etc.) is **\$20.00 per ton\***
- \*\$10.00 minimum scale charge for Commercially/Municipality hauled Class A Recyclables**

**II. Banning Unacceptable Materials**

Any recyclables delivered to the SCMUA Facility **cannot** contain any of the following contaminants in the recycling stream:

- Plastic bags/film/packaging material      Construction debris (wood/metal/glass)
- Food waste      Hazardous materials
- Single-Stream material\* (\*The SCMUA does not accept Single-Stream – See attached\*)

Haulers with contaminated material ***can and will be assessed re-loading & disposal charges***, in addition to potential enforcement penalties, in accordance with the SCMUA 2021 Rate Schedule.

The SCMUA has dedicated operations staff and resources, to maintain clean recycling streams at the Solid Waste/Recycling Facility. We ask for the cooperation of all those who utilize the facility, to ensure the above requirements are adhered to. Thank you for your continued efforts promoting recycling in Sussex County.
